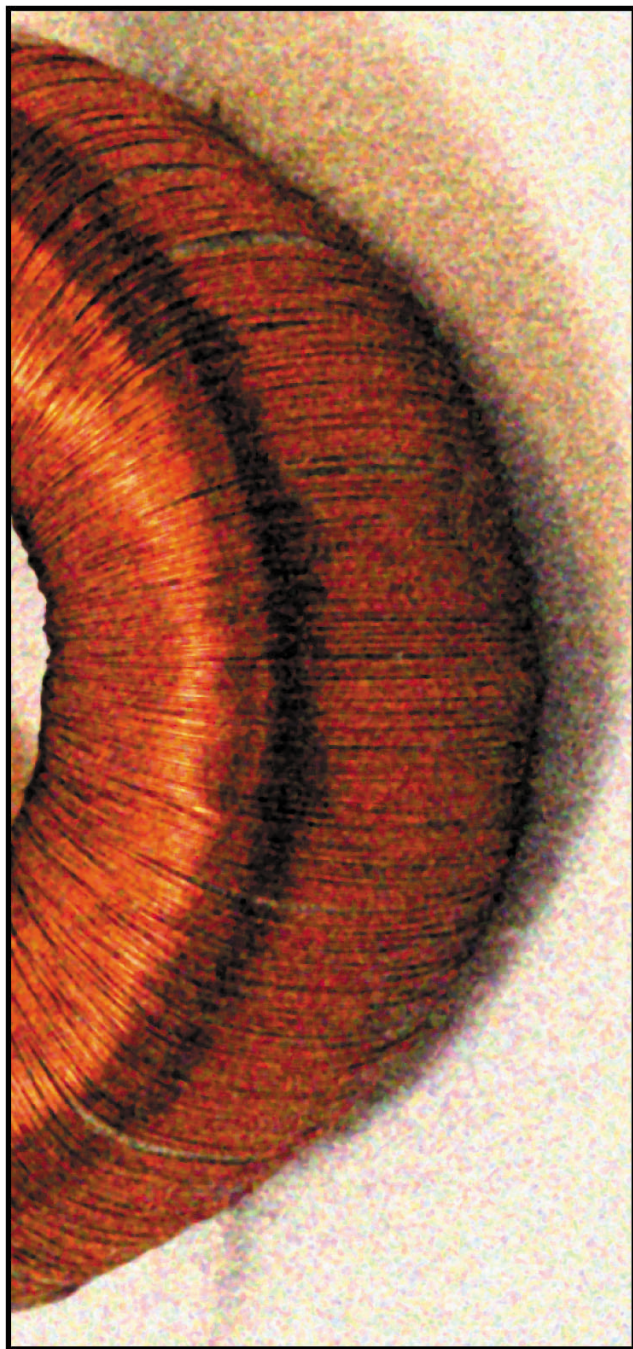


The Western Electric® 111C Line Transformer - Inside & Out
